Terms and Conditions

Inspection of Cattle:

Cattle may be inspected at the Hoosier Beef Congress starting Thursday, December 1st after 12:00 pm (noon) until Saturday, December 3 prior to the sale.

Terms:

Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder. The auctioneer will settle any dispute as to bids. All cattle are to be paid for by the purchaser during or immediately after the sale and will not be released until settlement has been made. Cattle will not be transferred until paid for in full. **All guarantees, including breeding guarantees, are strictly between the buyer and seller, the HBC does not take responsibility for any guarantees.**

Credit Cards:

We accept MasterCard, Visa and American Express

Absentee Bids:

If you are unable to attend the sale but would like to place a bid, you may do so by making arrangements with any of the sale staff prior to the sale. Or if you choose to bid "live" by phone, make those arrangements prior to the start of the sale with the sale staff.

Liability and Insurance:

Each animal will be the purchaser's risk immediately after the animal is sold. Insurance can be obtained by contacting the sale clerk.

All persons who attend the sale, do so at their own risk. The Hoosier Beef Congress Committee, Indiana Beef Cattle Association and the Consignors assume no liability, legal or otherwise, for any accident that may occur.

Health:

All cattle will be accompanied by proper health certificates for immediate shipment.

Registration Certificates:

The registration certificate of each animal will be transferred to the buyer at the consignor's expense. Each buyer must be sure to give the clerk his proper name and address for making transfers. All calves born after the sale are to be registered by the new owner. Proper breeding statements will be signed by the seller for the buyer to use in registering calves born after the sale.

Announcements:

All announcements at the sale by the owner or auctioneers concerning the cattle will take precedence over statements in the sale catalog.

Breeding Information:

The breeding information in the sale catalog is subject to change prior to the sale. Any changes in the breeding status of an animal will be noted and announced by the auctioneer.
